

Application for a study permit - Checklist

In addition to the documents listed in the standard document checklist, you must provide the following office specific documents as applicable. We accept documents in either English or French. You must include a certified translation of any documents that are in a different language.

These are minimum requirements. An officer will make a decision based on the documentation and evidence you provide in support of your application.

Study+ - Students who have been accepted into a Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctoral degree program in Canada:	√
Proof of employment or current studies - A letter from your current employer or school on official letterhead indicating your current position and salary or your current program of studies, as applicable.	
Evidence of previous studies and travel – Evidence of the completion of related previous studies and evidence of your previous international travel or studies, if applicable.	
Proof of income and funds – evidence to establish your financial resources including evidence of your income, personal assets and funds AND those of any individual helping to support your studies, if applicable.	
Family Information Form IMM 5707, fully completed, dated and signed.	
Other studies – In addition to the above three items, you must also submit:	√
Copy of your current immigration document, if applicable – For example, your study permit, work permit, or temporary resident permit.	
Evidence showing your purpose of studies – A copy of your curriculum vitae or resume and details of why you intend to undertake these studies in Canada.	
If you have answered "yes" to any of the background information questions on the application form, provide a completed and signed Schedule 1 form (Application for Temporary Resident Visa – IMM 5257B) and include it with your application.
