Application for a study permit – Checklist

Complete and place this checklist on top of your application.

Any document not in English or French must be accompanied by a certified translation.

Failure to submit all required documentation may result in the refusal of your application or processing delays.

It is normally advisable to wait until you receive the letter of authorization to study in Canada from the Embassy before paying tuition fees and finalizing travel plans.

Note: If you are a legal resident of Morocco who also currently resides there, and you have been accepted to study at a designated post-secondary school in Canada, you may be eligible to [get your study permit through the Student Direct Stream](#) if you apply online.

Two passport photographs for each applicant taken in the past six months. Write the name and birth date of the individual on the back.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Valid passport for each person requiring a temporary resident visa. Your passport should be valid for at least six months from the date of travel to Canada.</p> <p>Include all cancelled or expired passports, if applicable. The permit cannot be issued for a longer validity than the passport.</p> <p>If you do not reside in your country of citizenship, provide your work permit or temporary stay permit.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
If you are 18 years old and older , "Fiche anthropométrique" from Morocco and criminal records from all countries you have resided in for more than six months.	<input type="checkbox"/>

<p>Diplomas and transcripts obtained up to date, since the last two years of the BAC (High School) All official documents must be provided as certified true copies. Do not send original documents, but ensure that you have them in your possession, because you may be asked to produce them at any time.</p> <p>All documents in a language other than English or French must be translated and certified. Please submit a copy in the original language and the translation.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
A letter from the person providing you with financial assistance.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Proof of funds</p> <p>Proof that you, or the person who pays for your studies, can pay your tuition fees and support yourself while you are in Canada.</p> <p>Please note that the origin of funds must be properly documented and explained. In addition to the bank statements for the last six months, you should submit all other relevant documents and information showing incomes that are compatible with the presented funds (For example: income attestation, company registration, rental and agricultural income, etc.)</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Certificat d'Acceptation du Québec (CAQ) if you will study in a designated learning institution in the province of Quebec.</p> <p>You should contact the "<u>Ministère de l'Immigration, de la Diversité et de l'Inclusion</u>" to submit your CAQ application.</p> <p>Please note that additional fees for the CAQ apply and that visa issuance is not guaranteed when you get a CAQ. It is not necessary to submit the CAQ with your application but you should submit a proof that the CAQ application has already been made. We recommend that you obtain your CAQ prior to submitting your study permit application.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Proof of your language skills: TEF (French), IELTS OR TOEFL (English) test results (optional)	<input type="checkbox"/>

<p>If you submit your application less than 6 weeks before classes start, a letter from the learning institution clearly indicating the deadline for late admissions.</p> <p>*Applications submitted less than 4 weeks before classes start may be refused, since processing times are about 4-6 weeks.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>If you have answered "yes" to any of the background information questions on the application form, provide a completed and signed Schedule 1 form (Application for Temporary Resident Visa – IMM 5257B) and include it with your application.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
