Application for a temporary resident visa - Checklist

In addition to the documents listed in the standard document checklist, you must provide the following office specific documents as applicable. We accept documents in either English or French. You must include a certified translation of any documents that are in a different language.

These are minimum requirements. An officer will make a decision based on the documentation and evidence you provide in support of your application.

CAN+ - If you have travelled to Canada in the last ten (10) years or currently hold a valid United States non-immigrant visa and can provide proof (entry stamps in passport, proof of the valid visa), no proof of financial support is needed. For all others, provide proof of financial support to cover the expenses for the duration of your visit:	
Copies of bank statements or bank book - covering the past three months.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Any additional relevant documentation - (employment letter, pay slips, proof of pension, business registration, investments, etc.)	<input type="checkbox"/>
If you are not paying for your own trip:	
Provide a letter signed by the person paying and a photocopy of their passport, or other official identification with photo and signature and a bank certificate proving that they have sufficient funds. Describe how this person is related to you. These documents must be dated within three months of the date on which the application is submitted.	<input type="checkbox"/>
In addition, all applicants must provide the following:	
Evidence of your immigration status in the country of residence.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Proof of employment or current studies - A letter from your current employer or school on official letterhead indicating your current position and salary or your current program of studies, as applicable.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Evidence of previous travel – Evidence of previous international travel.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Evidence showing your purpose of travel – details of the specific individual, business, person, or event you will visit, as applicable.	<input type="checkbox"/>

<p>If you have answered "yes" to any of the background information questions on the application form, provide a completed and signed Schedule 1 form (Application for Temporary Resident Visa – IMM 5257B) and include it with your application.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Family Information Form IMM 5707, fully completed, dated and signed.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Diplomatic or official passport holders travelling for official government travel:</p>	
<p>In lieu of all the above, if you are a diplomatic or official passport holder travelling for official travel, you may submit a note verbale from your office stating your position, the duration of your current assignment to the country where you are posted if applicable, and the purpose of your travel to Canada.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
