### Application for a temporary resident visa - Checklist

In addition to the documents listed in the standard document checklist, you must provide the following office specific documents as applicable. We accept documents in either English or French. You must include a certified translation of any documents that are in a different language.

These are minimum requirements. An officer will make a decision based on the documentation and evidence you provide in support of your application.

<b>CAN+</b> - If you have travelled to Canada in the last ten (10) years or currently hold a valid Unites States non-immigrant visa and can provide proof (entry stamps in passport, proof of the valid visa), no proof of financial support is needed. For all others, provide proof of financial support to cover the expenses for the duration of your visit:	
Copies of bank statements or bank book - covering the past three months.	
<b>Any additional relevant documentation -</b> (employment letter, pay slips, proof of pension, business registration, investments, etc.)	
If you are not paying for your own trip:	
<b>Provide a letter</b> signed by the person paying and a photocopy of their passport, or other official identification with photo and signature and a bank certificate proving that they have sufficient funds. Describe how this person is related to you. These documents must be dated within three months of the date on which the application is submitted.	
In addition, all applicants must provide the following:	
Evidence of your immigration status in the country of residence.	
<b>Proof of employment or current studies -</b> A letter from your current employer or school on official letterhead indicating your current position and salary or your current program of studies, as applicable.	
Evidence of previous travel – Evidence of previous international travel.	
<b>Evidence showing your purpose of travel</b> – details of the specific individual, business, person, or event you will visit, as applicable.	

If you have answered "yes" to any of the background information questions on the application form, provide a completed and signed <b>Schedule 1</b> form (Application for Temporary Resident Visa – IMM 5257B) and include it with your application.
